

SPECIFICATION SECTION 01620

RESTORTATION OF INFRASTRUCTURE AFFECTED BY CONSTRUCTION

1. DESCRIPTION

At the completion of construction and prior to the request for the issue of the Taking-Over Certificate the local public roads used for construction shall be; cleaned, reinstated to the original condition (including rectification of structures) and be ready for use by the road users and the Local Authorities subject to the areas where the Contract stipulates otherwise.

The Contractor, in conjunction with the Engineer, shall make a survey of the condition of the local public roads and all other permanent roads likely to be affected by construction activities; including the compiling of a detailed photographic record prior to the commencement of the Works on Site. This record shall be subject to the approval of the Engineer and shall be submitted to the Engineer as an official record at the completion of the survey.

2. STANDARDS, MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT

The Subbase, Base and Leveling Courses shall conform with the requirements of Specification Section 05100.

The Prime Coat and Tack Coat shall conform with the requirements of Specification Section 06100.

The surface course shall conform with the requirements of Specification Section 06200 Asphalt Concrete Binder and Surface Courses.

3. MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

3.1 Method of Measurement

A Provisional Sum has been included in the Bill of Quantities for the restoration of local public roads and other related works, which may or may not be expended by the Employer, as a provision for work, the extent of which cannot be defined prior to the letting of the Contract.

The preparation and submission of the survey of the local public roads and the detailed photographic provisions this Specification Section shall be measured for payment as Inherently Paid Work.

3.2 Basis of Payment

Payment for; the preparation and submission of the survey of the local public roads and the detailed photographic record in compliance with this Specification Section shall be deemed to be Inherently Paid Work, which is included or distributed among

all the rates and prices entered in the unit prices of the Bills of Quantities. No separate payment will be made for these Works.
